**The Taking Action curriculum** provides a common understanding of elder abuse and promotes a cross-sectoral approach to developing a shared understanding and learning amongst multiple, blended stakeholder groups. **The target audience** for Taking Action includes all front-line staff who in the scope of their work, interact with older adults and victims of elder abuse and family violence.

**Unit One:** The Unique Nature of Elder Abuse

**Unit Two:** Recognizing Elder Abuse - An exploration of the risk factors and indicators of elder

abuse.

**Unit Three:** Referring Victims of Elder Abuse - An identification of strategies for referring victims of elder abuse to the resources that can support them.

**Unit Four:** Responding to Incidences of Elder Abuse - an approach that provides all front-line staff with a basis for responding to incidences of elder abuse.

**Unit Five:** Reconnecting with Victims of Elder Abuse -the importance of following up with victims of elder abuse.
